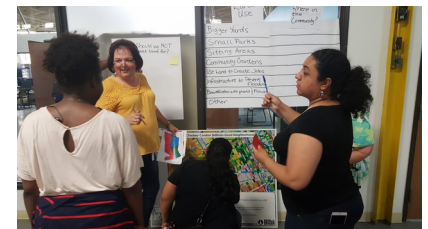

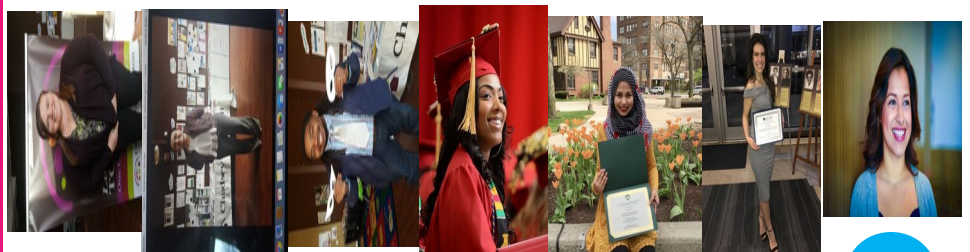

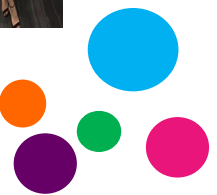
In partnership with Metropolitan Detroit Diaper Bank we **distribute diapers** to over 60 families at our office each month.

In November of 2018 we launched two new committees. The **Neighborhood Inclusion Committee** and the **Community House Task Force**. Look for more about their work in 2019.



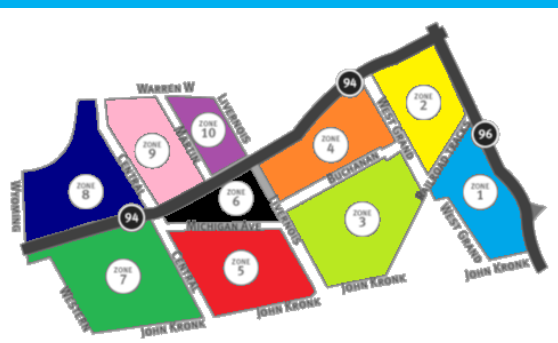
